

Tiki vs Plone

Similar

- Both are full-featured free and open source web applications.
- Both are community-run projects
- Both have large & vibrant communities

Different

- Plone is GPL, Tiki is LGPL. [The main difference between the GPL and the LGPL is that the latter can be linked to \(in the case of a library, 'used by'\) a non-\(L\)GPLed program, which may be free software or proprietary software.](#)
- Tiki can run on standard, inexpensive hosting while [Plone needs more.](#)
- Plone is written in Python, while Tiki is in PHP.
- Plone started in 1999, and Tiki in 2002
