Tiki is a community-driven project with a network of service providers (not [Single-Vendor Commercial Open Source](#)). Our "Wiki Way" of software development emphasizes collaboration on scale unlike most other applications.

With over 1 million downloads, an international team including 500+ developers with commit access, 10+ years of active development, and a new version every 6 months, the Tiki Community is amongst the FOSS projects with the most momentum.
