

# Continuity

A benefit of Tiki as a project and as a community is stability and continuity.

The Tiki project has been going on strong since October 2002.

All the information (code, wiki, forum, etc) has been *building knowledge* since the beginning. The vast majority of information & code about the project is centralized under \*.tiki.org sites and on SourceForge.net

What this avoids:

- Broken links to external sites (Which have documentation, code, etc.)
- Duplicated, fragmented information due to people working in different places.

But it's not perfect. Sometimes, there is duplication. Efforts are ongoing to clarify [where](#) to put *stuff* and increase collaboration.
