- Don't paste a lot of code/error msgs into IRC, use a pastebin instead. See the [Comparison of pastebins](#) page at Wikipedia.org for a list of pastebins.

- #tikiwiki is very informal - enjoy!
- You can read the last messages at <http://irc.tiki.org>
- Say hi & feel free to ask your question - no need to ask for permission
- Please remember that everyone is a volunteer and set your expectations accordingly
- If you don't get an answer promptly, try returning in a few hours and asking again
