

# Tiki vs Magnolia

---

## Similar

- Both are enterprise content management systems.
- Both are part of [CMS Focus](#)

## Different

- Tiki is [community open source](#) while Magnolia is [single-vendor commercial open source](#). Thus, Magnolia has a "community" version and an "enterprise" version.
  - [Most of the committers here work for Magnolia](#), whereas in Tiki contributions come from various [organizations](#)
- Alfresco is written in Java whereas Tiki is written in PHP.
- Tiki hosting requirements are easier ([shared hosting](#))
- Tiki [dogfoods](#) its own wiki where as [Magnolia uses Confluence](#), a commercial wiki engine
- Tiki has more built-in features, well, because Tiki is the [FLOSS Web Application with the most built-in features](#)
  - In Tiki, you get all these features built-in and as Open Source, whereas in Magnolia, some features you could want, like a Mobile version, "[you need a Enterprise Edition of Magnolia](#)"
