### Similar

- Both are community managed free and open source web applications with a powerful wiki.
- Both support Wiki markup. Please see (if) [Why Wiki Syntax Is Important](#) to your project.

### Different

- MoinMoin uses files for storage whereas Tiki uses the MySQL database. In future versions, MoinMoin will have a DB storage option.
- MoinMoin is in Python whereas Tiki is in PHP.
- MoinMoin is focused on being a great Wiki (which it is!), whereas Tiki is more of a [Content Management System / general purpose wiki](#).
- MoinMoin is GPL, Tiki is LGPL. [The main difference between the GPL and the LGPL is that the latter can be linked to \(in the case of a library, 'used by'\) a non-\(L\)GPLed program, which may be free software or proprietary software.](#)
