Similar

- Both Tiki, XWiki (along with TWiki) are free and open source enterprise/applications wikis.
- Both support Wiki markup. Please see (if) Why Wiki Syntax Is Important to your project.
- Both are LGPL, which is a less commonly used license than the GPL. The main difference between the GPL and the LGPL is that the latter can be linked to (in the case of a library, 'used by') a non-(L)GPLed program, which may be free software or proprietary software.
- Both use a database, such as MySQL.

Different

- XWiki is written in Java whereas Tiki is written in PHP.
- Tiki hosting requirements are easier (shared hosting)
